Jeffry's son, Zachary, now 14

was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes when he was only $1\frac{1}{2}$ years old. Zachary, pictured here, is currently using an insulin pump and wants to write video games as a profession!

Jeffry and Ellen have been active volunteers as leaders in parent support groups, assisting parents with newly diagnosed kids, and as volunteers for various DRI events since Zachary was initially diagnosed.

Ellen created and maintains a web site for parent of kids with Diabetes using the insulin pump called KidsRPumping at http://www.kidsrpumping.com.

Jeffry had the Diabetes Research Institute listed as an IBM ECCC eligible organization for IBMers throughout South Florida and the US to direct their ECCC donations if they so choose.
